





1. Overall number of people per ward (QS104EW)




2. Population Density in Persons / ha (QS102EW)




3. Population Pyramid for Reading, 2011 (QS104EW)




4. Proportion of students per ward (QS603EW)



1. Proportion of Population by Ethnic Group (QS201EW)




2. Distribution of Ethnic groups at ward level (QS201EW)



3. Country of Birth, by Ward (QS203EW)



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5. Proportion of Asian/Asian British Residents, by Ward (KS201EW)



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




9. Proportion of Residents by Religion, Reading (KS208EW)




7. Main language spoken, by ward (QS204EW)




10. Proportion of Residents Identifying as Christian, by Ward (KS208EW)




1. Proportion of residents (16-74) in Employment (QS612EW)




3. Proportion of all usual residents long-term unemployed (QS605EW)




2. Proportion of residents (16-74) in Employment, by Ward (QS612EW)




4. Proportion of residents (16-74) in Employment, by Industry (QS605EW)




5. Proportion of residents (16-74) who have never worked, by Ward (QS605EW)




6. Number of households with no deprivation, by ward (QS119EW)



7. Household by deprivation index for Reading (QS119EW)




8. Highest Qualification Attained, Reading (QS502EW)


10. Proportion of households with car/van ownership by ward (QS416EW)


## 3. Typical weekly duration of unpaid care by ward (QS301EW)


## 2. Proportion of population economically inactive due to long term illness with dependent children by ward (KS106EW)


## 6. Proportion of population reporting good or very good health by ward (QS302EW)



## 3. Number of residents with no central heating. (QS415EW)



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
## 4. Proportion of all households with amenities in Reading (QS415EW)






**8. Number of Overcrowded Households, by ward (QS408EW)**

**10. Proportion by wards of all households with overcrowding by ward (QS408EW)**








## 3. Household Composition Percentages, England (QS113EW)




## 4. Household Composition Percentages, Reading (QS113EW)




## 5. Household Size, Ward Level (QS406EW)



6. Proportion of households which are couple households, by ward (no children) (KS105EW)




8. Proportion of families in households who are families with dependent children by ward (QS118EW)






9. Characteristics of households with dependent children, by ward (QS118EW)



10. Proportion of hidden and other households, by ward (QS116EW)




11. Proportion with no adults in employment in household by ward (KS106EW)



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12. Proportion of households with no adults in employment, with and without dependent children, by ward (KS106EW)







## 3. Proportion of population who are homeowners and the % change from 2001 and 2011 Census (KS18/KS402EW)





## 6. Proportion of population reporting good or very good health by MSA (KS08/KS301EW)





4. Male: Female Ratio in 2001 and 2011 (KS01/KS101EW)






## 2. % change in Home Ownership levels from 2001 and 2011 Census (KS18/KS402EW)






3. Proportion of population reporting good or very good health by MSOA (KS08/KS301EW)
