




#### 4. Proportion of students per ward (QS603EW)




#### 1. Proportion of Population by Ethnic Group (QS201EW)



4. Proportion of White (British, Other) Residents, by ward (KS201EW)




#### 9. Proportion of Residents by Religion, Reading (KS208EW)




#### 7. Main language spoken, by ward (QS204EW)




# 10. Proportion of Residents Identifying as Christian, by Ward (KS208EW)







# 2. Proportion of population economically inactive due to long term illness with dependent children by ward (KS106EW)













#### 5. Household Size, Ward Level (QS406EW)




#### 4. Household Composition Percentages, Reading (QS113EW)



## 6. Proportion of households which are couple households, by ward (no children) (KS105EW)








#### 9. Characteristics of households with dependent children, by ward (QS118EW)








### 2. All Usual Resident Population Change from 2001 and 2011 Census (KS01/KS101EW)

#### 4. Male: Female Ratio in 2001 and 2011 (KS01/KS101EW)






2. % change in Home Ownership levels from 2001 and 2011 Census (KS18/KS402EW)



2. % change in 16-74 year olds economically active (KS09A/KS601EW)








