**SIDMOUTH STREET
(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE)
NOTICE 2020**

Reading Borough Council GIVES NOTICE under s14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) that the following restrictions will be implemented:

1. Sidmouth Street will be a one-way street, south to north, between its junctions with London Road and Queens Road.
2. The eastern side of the carriageway on Sidmouth Street will become a segregated, two-way cycle lane between its junctions with London Road and Queens Road.
3. Suspension of the Zone 11R Resident Permit Holders only waiting restriction on Sidmouth Street, located on the east side, from a point 38 metres south of its junction with South Street to a point 68 metres south of that junction.
4. No Waiting at Any Time on Sidmouth Street, east side, from a point 38 metres south of its junction with South Street to a point 68 metres south of that junction.

The restrictions are required from 27th July 2020 to 16th August 2020.

The restrictions are necessary under s14(2)(b) because of the likelihood of danger to the public in supporting active travel plans and social distancing during the Covid-19 pandemic.
