Comment: I feel more thought should be given to better address concerns raised at the public consultations, namely, that there is little consideration for resident/visitor parking, impact on traffic and public transport (especially infrequent and already overcrowded bus routes N of station), and no specific and committed provision of additional crucial infrastructure eg schools, grocery and domestic shopping (since Aldi has been essential for local residents), and doctor and dentist surgeries (of which there are already too few in Reading). Finally, a rethink is needed regarding the need for more office space in this post-pandemic world, where it is thought 10-20% more people will be working from home rather than using an office.
