Good afternoon Leanne,

Yesterday morning, the Inspector flagged the duplication of drawing reference numbers used by CHP Surveyors ("CHP") in some of the material exchanged between CHP and Dr Paul Littlefair. I have flagged this with CHP, who have responded as follows:

*We note the Inspector's comment that we have duplicated the drawing reference 2271-206 and 207 and apologise for this.*

*We would confirm that the drawings 2271-206 and 207 attached to CD12.6 related to the colour coded room map for the first and second floor of Block B of the Illustrative Scheme which is different to the drawing numbers 2271-206 and 207 which show the location of the sample rooms analysed within the 80 Caversham Road Illustrative Scheme.*

*We apologise for this duplication of drawing numbers but hope the above clarifies the matter.*

As set out in the above response, both sets of drawings relate to the Illustrative Scheme, and as such do not form part of the drawings/plans that the appellant has submitted for approval. Accordingly, whilst the duplication is unhelpful, we do not consider that it necessitates the renumbering of the drawings for the purposes of the inquiry.

I trust that this clarifies the situation and my apologies for any confusion caused.
